South West College values each individual learner and asserts each one has the following rights:

- to study in a friendly, welcoming atmosphere;
- to enjoy and use all of the facilities that the College offers and to feel safe and secure in College premises;
- to an induction programme, which introduces them to the College, and to their own particular programme;
- to have previous achievements and qualifications recognised and valued;
- to an individual learning plan;
- to know how they will learn and how they will be assessed and accredited;
- assessment which is fair and unbiased;
- to be treated with respect by other students and by staff; The South West College has an Equal Opportunities policy which states that any mistreatment of an individual because of religious belief, political opinion, racial group, age, marital status, gender, sexual orientation, disability or dependency will be treated seriously;
- help and support with problems that are affecting their learning;
